The \$75M Banksia Apartments is an 18-level residential tower highlighted by striking architecture inspired by the native Australian Banksia flower, replicated in the curved structure and circlet-crown façade. It comprises 108 high end apartments configured across penthouses, sky-homes and classic apartments and features rooftop amenities complete with an infinity pool and ground floor tenancy.

Destined to become Melbourne's next iconic building and situated in NewQuay Docklands, the Banksia development has been planned to complement and contribute to its surrounds.

Designed by McBride Charles Ryan, Banksia comprises 108 apartments, configured across penthouse, sky-home and classic apartment iterations and available in four different schemes. Common areas include rooftop function rooms and gymnasium complete with outdoor plunge pools and spa. Additionally, the building incorporates a ground floor tenancy and basement car parking, and will be connected to Docklands Drive by a purpose-built access cul-de-sac.

Surrounded by a lush parkland on the edge of Victoria Harbour, Banksia's unique position ensures panoramic 360 degree park and water views back-dropped by Melbourne's city skyline. The tower itself is highlighted by striking architecture, which has been inspired by the native Australian Banksia flower, replicated in the curved structure and circlet-crown façade.

Contracted to build the project for developer MAB Corporation was innovative construction company Hickory Group. Its scope of work included the demolition of the existing promenade plaza, followed by construction of the 18-storey high end residential waterfront apartment tower with basement carpark and rooftop amenities.

Hickory was also contracted to provide the extensive upgrade to the surrounding landscape. As part of the local planning provisions, the Banksia project is subject to achieve 5 Star Green Star equivalence.

To meet this criteria, a range of ecologically sustainable development initiatives have been implemented, based on the Green Star multi-residential rating tool developed by the Green Building Council of Australia.

The expansive public park, which adjoins the development, further creates an attractive space for enjoyment between the waterfront and the Docklands shopping precinct.

"The park will provide an inviting, highly adaptable area of public open space that will be able to be utilised for community events such as markets and art exhibitions, while also providing space for family enjoyment," says Project Manager, Morrie Bahri.

Its underground car park, just metres from the sea and below high tide, meant works had to be completed in accordance with tide times. "Construction works were required to coordinate with the tides of the sea," explains Morrie. "The carpark structural shell was also required to be fully membraned to ensure a complete water-tight system."

"The design, fabrication, transit and installation of the intricate FRP façade system [also] posed many challenges. Particularly,

achieving the visual intent while respecting engineering constraints such as wind pressures, thermal expansion and contraction and general constructability.

"The use of 3D modelling and double curved fabrication techniques assisted in achieving the intricate FRP façade system that emulates the curves and peaks of an elegant Banksia flower."

Hickory started work on site in April 2016, with an expected completion date in December 2017. The Banksia project has seen approximately 250 people working onsite at the construction's peak.

"With an emphasis on safety and quality, we continuously invest in developing our people and systems to improve the way we build and deliver the best outcome for our clients," says Morrie.

In addition to the Banksia development, Hickory constructed the adjoining Aquil Promenade residential towers for MAB Corporation. Other current projects for Hickory include 50 La Trobe Street Student Accommodation, Conservatory, The Fifth, Lakeside, Collins House and Opera.

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
