With the goal of providing premium accommodation and state-of-the-art business and conference facilities, the East Hotel's brief to engineers John Raineri & Associates was to design flexible systems for all possible combinations of clientele, from travelling families to corporate conferences.

The Canberra-based consultancy's services covered everything from the electronic to the environmental. "JRA was responsible for

the design and documentation of electrical, communications, mechanical heating, cooling and ventilation and fire services for the project," said director John Raineri.

Facilities at the 4.5 star hotel include room configurations that can be set-up and connected as theatres, boardroom and training classrooms. The challenge was met by centralising an internal computer control room onsite. "This is a compact and complicated building that required a high degree of service coordination

between architectural, structural, and building disciplines," said Mr Raineri.

"There are specialist services, such as Internet Protocol TV signal distribution, sophisticated lighting and power consumption controls, the latest technology in hotel room access controls, Wi-Fi distribution systems, telephony and data access, car parking control and billing systems. To accommodate the building's technological sophistication there is a fully functioning internal computer room on the premises."


