The \$45 million WaterMarc project sets a new bench mark for leisure and aquatic centres in Victoria.

There are plenty of ways to enjoy getting wet at WaterMarc, the new Aquatic and Fitness Centre at Greensborough in Melbourne's northern suburbs. This state of the art community facility has been delivered by ADCO Constructions on behalf of Banyule City Council and features Australia's first Tantrum Alley waterslide. The project represents one of the largest and most important community developments completed in the Greensborough area.

WaterMarc provides the local community with a number of different swimming options including a 50m competition standard pool, a learn

to swim pool, toddler pool and hydrotherapy pool. Extensive fitness areas have also been provided including a fully equipped gymnasium and multiple fitness program rooms. Back of house facilities include change rooms, meeting rooms, a crèche and a café.

The facility will be utilised by many local community groups for activities such as learn to swim classes, school swimming carnivals, aquatic exercise classes and rehabilitation programs. As well as meeting these community needs the active water spaces, including the Tantrum Alley waterslide, provide a major source of entertainment for the kids. WaterMarc will be managed by Belgravia Leisure on behalf of Banyule Council with expectations of over 750,000 visits to the facility per annum.

ADCO's team commenced the \$45 million project in November 2010 and successfully managed the significant technical challenges associated with a project of this scale. The project was completed on time for its scheduled opening in September 2012. The striking design by Architects



Peddle Thorp utilises natural light and bright colours to provide an open and welcoming feel. Extensive use of timber in the lobby areas has created a unique high quality entry statement.

WaterMarc represents the latest in a range of successful aquatic projects completed by ADCO. Recent notable projects include Maribyrnong and Bayfit Aquatic and Fitness centres in Melbourne as well as the Knox Grammar and Kincoppal School Aquatic Centres in Sydney. 
