LUXURY ON THE PARK

354 Bowden is an inspiring, mixed-use development which features 225 meticulously designed apartments across five buildings. Boasting spacious, light-filled residences, architectural finishes and an enviable location just a stone's throw away from the city centre, the project also includes retail spaces and a shared community courtyard.

Delivered by proud South Australian company, Buildtec, 354 Bowden is a winning combination of luxury and location, with premium apartments to suit all lifestyles including sky lofts, terrace housing and two or three-bedroom residences.

For more than 50 years, Buildtec has been actively shaping South Australia through an impressive portfolio of property development and construction properties across the residential, commercial and industrial sectors. The company's latest work here at 354 Bowden on Park West is no exception and further demonstrates Buildtec's extensive experience in design, construction and project management.

When the site was released by the South Australian Government in what is an existing industrial area, the potential for creating something special in the emerging neighbourhood was undeniable.

Buildtec was awarded the project as part of the State Government's Renewal SA initiative to blend history, culture, architecture and sustainability together into a vibrant, inner-city destination. A key requirement for Buildtec was to create a precinct on the perimeter of Adelaide City that met the demographic, whilst adding clean architecture across the development as a whole.

"The scope for 354 Bowden was to deliver a medium-density residential project and when the site became available, Buildtec was looking to undertake a significant benchmark project in Adelaide's urban infill areas," Michael said. "The design of this project captures the industrial heritage of Bowden with its monoblock forms and racking roof lines, but also represents a clean architectural form with modern detailing and finishes."

Buildtec's team was onsite at 354 Bowden for 3.5 years and all employees were responsible for day-to-day problem solving and project management. All team members coordinated with trades to schedule in works and safety management was everyone's responsibility.

"As we only operate in the South Australian market, we prefer to employ and work with

all South Australian companies and promote growth in our State where possible," Michael explained. "In saying that, we also welcome new companies and look forward to building healthy and trusting relationships."

The project was not without its challenges, but Buildtec's experience and industry know-how held the company in good stead. Completed over two stages, the most challenging aspect for the project team was handing over five buildings and 2-levels of underground carparking at different times, whilst maintaining a construction site.

"From a construction point-of-view, 354 Bowden's journey was extremely different to all of the buildings currently in the Bowden area," Michael explained. "It has the largest basement in the area spanning two levels of underground carparking across at 5,000m² block and the project also incorporated a tower crane during construction for the basement and three of the buildings and this is the only project in the area to achieve such a task."

A project where modern living meets first-class amenities, 354 Bowden features high ceilings, walk-in robes, open-plan living, stainless steel appliances and ample storage and has been constructed to cater to all tastes.

"354 Bowden has been an extremely successful project where we have delivered 225-apartments across five buildings to the local area of Bowden, including four retail spaces and a community courtyard to be shared," Michael said. "The location is vibrant and highly attractive as it's close to Adelaide's City Centre and not only does it cater to first home buyers, but attracts a range of demographics across the different buildings."

Buildtec is currently working on the Norwood Green precinct on Magill Road in Norwood and their work can be seen all across South Australia, including collaborations with various community housing providers.

bathrooms and in the other buildings, we installed the vanities as well as the kitchen benchtops and splashbacks, we've used SileStone White Storm throughout."


SteedForm have had three to four crews onsite at 354 Bowden for the last two years and are currently completing the final stages.
