The 12-storey mixed use Edge 28 in the heart of St Leonards has 3-levels of basement car parking, a 4-storey podium with commercial and retail tenancies and an 8-storey residential tower comprising 48 apartments.

Novati Constructions was awarded the \$21 million construct only contract for Edge 28 in early September 2016 and work started onsite 19 days later.

Inside the units have large balconies, stylish finishes and sweeping unobstructed views to the east. The rooftop terrace comprises tiled flooring, luxurious seating and eating areas. Architectural plantings, with further plantings are featured on Levels 7 and 8 and bring a touch of nature into the development.

“The structure is of in situ concrete core, walls and floors with columns and blade walls of Ritek. The façade is clad with Equiton fibre cement panels and Diversaclad as well as a Corten feature on the top 6-storeys of the residential tower,” said Project Manager, Anthony Melia.

The Albany Street site is within a busy area of residential, commercial and retail activities and, with up to 145 workers onsite during peak periods, much planning was required for the movement of labour and materials over the three year build. “The site was only 730m². It was challenging to build in such a tight site with bulk services,” said Anthony.

Embracing new technology, Edge 28 is the first lettable building in the area to be marketed using state-of-the-art VR tours. Computer generated images and drone photography have been used to give potential buyers a virtual look at the apartments before they were constructed.

Since 1971, Novati Constructions has been delivering projects in new construction, refurbishment and heritage restoration within the Sydney basin. Novati Constructions provides design management, value engineering and cost planning as well as quality construction services specialising as head building contractor.

Novati Constructions recently completed the Harris Park project for the client Catholic Diocese of Parramatta; and the Mirabell

PANEL PERFECTION

D&L International are experts in the supply and installation of internal plasterboard walls and ceilings, and external cladding. For Edge 28, D&L International's team of 20, installed gyprock partition walls and ceilings across all the units and common internal areas, in addition to fitting 500m² of Equiton panels to the façades.

The company were responsible for installing the unique architectural feature made of 12 silver coloured metal panels designed to rust over a few weeks. They also installed 150m² of Diversaclad – a new product for D&L International, specified by the architect due to its aesthetic and lightweight composition.



“Diversaclad is a designed system of interlocking panels with mechanical fixings to battens,” said Owner, Nick Dong. “The installation required proper planning to build a sub frame and battens onto concrete walls.”

“The job went well, it was scheduled properly, and the trades worked well together,” said Nick. “This is our second job for Novati. Previously we worked on No 1 Wharf Road, installing walls and ceilings across all 62 apartments and common areas. Last year we completed a two year long job on a \$30 million luxury residence in Cremorne. The house is huge with 4-storeys that were 600m², we fitted all the walls and ceilings there.”

Established in 2010, D&L International employs 15 trades and subcontracts labour for larger projects. Nick has over 20 years personal experience in the industry, mostly working on high end residential jobs. The company supply and install partition walls, fire rated walls, plasterboard and Hebel panel walls. They also provide plasterboard ceilings as well as ceiling tiles for acoustic and thermal insulation.

D&L International is primarily a plastering contractor for commercial projects including Westfield Shopping Centres and the enormous Bing Lee shop in Mount Druitt where they installed plasterboard walls and partitions, ceiling panels and tiles and fire rated walls.

Dincel structural wall systems are ideal for both above and below ground applications. In basements and retaining walls, they require minimal clearance for installation, are waterproof and quick to install. Dincel can also be used for columns, load bearing walls, façades walls and are a fire compliant cladding system, having been classed as a deemed-to-satisfy solution to ISO 9705 and deemed suitable as a performance based solution to AS 5113/BS 8414. Other applications



for Dincel also include swimming pools, planter boxes, fences, as well as tanks, cable pits, culverts, sea walls and erosion control.

Dincel manufacturing and warehousing facilities are located in Erskine Park and Kemps Creek New South Wales, and the company also have offices and warehouses in Victoria and Queensland.
